


Codicote C of E Primary School



We write to introduce ourselves, Coulson & Son Ltd, as the Main Contractors who have been appointed by Hertfordshire County Council to deliver the new classroom block and existing school alterations at Codicote C of E Primary School.

The above picture highlights the site plan and the areas where the construction work will take place. The main school entrance will be the access point to gain entry onto site. Our site access will be on the left after going through the main gates.

The building is single storey and the structure will be formed with SIPs (Structural Insulated Panels) which will be formed off site. Once delivered and installed, the panels will be cladded and bricked around. The building has a 'green roof' roof type of construction. The car park will be re-worked and situated where the current temporary classroom is.

The first period of construction work will be the groundworks which will consist of the drainage and foundations.

At the same time as this, the internal works to the existing school will be taking place to ensure it's ready for the new term to begin in September.
