Read on for messages from your teachers ...

Good morning Nursery.

The chicks are growing and growing! It's hard to measure them though - they keep moving too much!

You might already have measured yourself and made a mark to see how tall you were. Have you grown since you made the mark? Can you find things to measure in your house? Start with your favourite toy. Use blocks or bricks like Lego to see how long it is. Can you find things that you think will be more or fewer Lego blocks long?, Can you find something that is taller or shorter than you?

Remember to tap each of the LEGO blocks in turn while counting to find out how long your toys are. You can even see if you can guess exactly how many bricks it will be and then check to see how close you were. If you've got one, you could use a tape measure or ruler and have a go at reading some numbers off it.

I might be brave and see how many bricks high the chicks are!
