


#### **Breakfast Club and 326 Club**

Thank you so much for bearing with us as we introduce the new system for booking and paying for wrap around care on Arbor. The aim is to make it much easier for parents to track bookings and payments to make things much clearer and easier. We will make any tweaks necessary to enable this to happen.

Please be reassured that regular bookings will continue; for those who have not yet done so, please could we ask you to add these to Arbor for the rest of the term/academic year, so that those children who always attend on particular days will be able to do so. Balances for sessions attended should be settled by the end of that half term, so that by the end of the Academic Year, all balances have been paid. You are able to make payments whenever suits your family (daily/weekly/monthly/termly) directly on Arbor, or using Tax-Free Childcare/Childcare Vouchers, or paying by cash/cheque to the office.

The benefits of the new system is that if all of the spaces are booked, and a call needs to be made to the office, this alerts us to the fact that we need to call on additional staff earlier, to ensure we have the ratios needed for the children. **Water Bottles** 

We are really pleased that the children are so good at remembering their water bottles and keeping them topped up. To preserve the children's teeth, as they drink from them throughout the day, they need to be filled with water and not squash or fizzy drinks. There have been some issues with Stanley cups leaking in the children's bags, and metal straws being used. These need to be replaced with flexible ones, as the metal straws have been recognised as a health risk if a child should fall or trip whilst drinking from them. Thank you for your support.
