### **Year 6 Leavers fundraising**

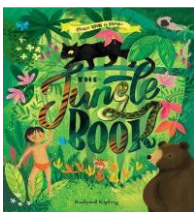

### **Donations for Ukraine**

We have previously supported aid donations for people affected by the war in Ukraine. This time we are supporting Felsted Aid who will be leaving the UK in early June. They would like donations of:

- Food (long-life, cans)
- Toiletries
- Ladies' sanitary products
- Medical items, including medicines in their original packaging with at least six months before expiry
- Baby and maternity items

Due to ongoing power cuts, they are also collecting lighting and power items, including lamps, torches, power banks, candles, and solar lanterns.

All donations should be brought into school by Tuesday 19th May. Thank you for your continued kindness and support.
