Dear Parents and Carers,

We have all been enjoying the lovely weather – particularly Year 6 who have been on the Isle of Wight. They have been having an amazing time, and I am looking forward to seeing them all when they get back tonight.

We have set the gazebos up on the field, and have the areas under the canopies to give the children some shade. Thank you for remembering to put suntan lotion on your child before they come to school and for sending them in with hats. Every class has mains tap water so we are able to fill the children's water bottles up, throughout the day. We are monitoring the weather forecast closely, in case we need to make any adaptations or changes to activities planned.



#### Classes for next year

We are now in a position to share who will be leading each class next year. Before I do so, I need to share the news that Mr Pyle has accepted a post at a school in Nantwich, Cheshire, and will be moving there over the summer, to be nearer to his girlfriend. We are obviously very sad, as we love working with him and he is a huge asset to the school over a long period of time – as a pupil as well as a teacher! However, we celebrate this excellent career opportunity for him, and hope he comes back to Codicote in the future – the door is open! We will be welcoming back Mrs Wood, from Maternity leave in September.

As everyone is aware, the school is currently expanding – we welcomed 15 additional children to the school during the year. We are anticipating an increase in numbers in Year 1 for September, so Miss Grainger will be joining Miss Churchill. Both teachers will teach the class. Numbers will be kept under review regarding when/if it becomes appropriate to split the year group in two, as will be the case for all single class year groups.

There have been a number of changes to the children in Year 2, and following careful consideration, we will be mixing the current Year 2 class into different groupings for Year 3. Further details regarding this will be sent home by letter today. As the current Year 3 children were only split last year, the children will remain in the same classes. Mr Pyle's class will be taught by Miss Doran next year and Miss Clark's class will be taught by Mr Massey.

Where there are two classes in a year group, the children will be working with both teachers, and different groupings of children throughout the week.
